
HCRTCGULTURE SECTOR

Adam has the opportunity to take part in work experience every Friday with Beyond Boundaries where he is able to use and develop his skills in Farm work / Practical Skills / Animal Care

Adam's work Placement is at Fowl Green Farm in Commondale.

This is what Adam has to say about his placement.

What jobs do you do at Beyond Boundaries?

At Beyond Boundaries I do lots of practical tasks like building different wood items, looking after farm animals such as llamas, donkeys, sheep, pigs, dogs, chickens and goats. We also buy tools and equipment and make fires and tidy the farm and garden.

What activities have you enjoyed taking part in?

I have enjoyed walking the farm animals and I also like constructing wood products to sell for enterprise.

What have you learnt whilst working there?

I have learnt how to work as part of a team better. I am also getting better at my maths because I have been learning how to measure angles and lengths with rulers and tape measures accurately. Using tools and equipment more safely. Taking care of the animals, carrying out the instructions and concentrating on the tasks at hand.

ROUTES OF PROGRESSION & TRAINING


You could work for a garden centre or tend to plants in a public garden.
