“KTS are very, very proud of Skye and her achievements.”



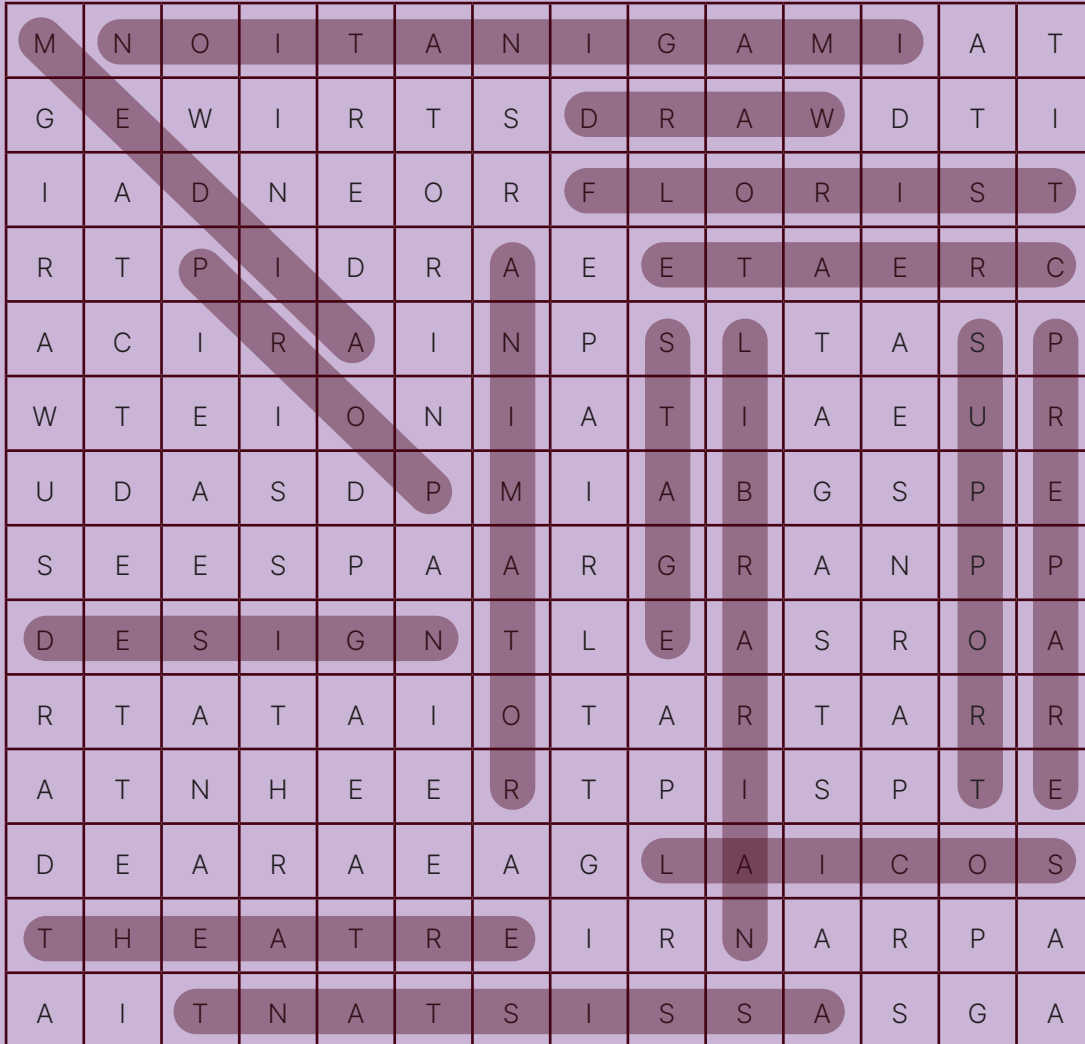

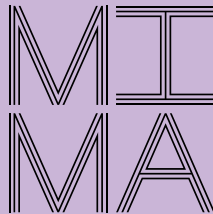

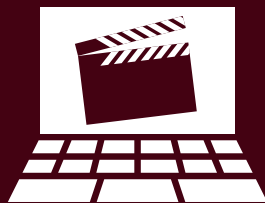

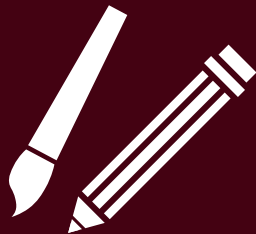
The average annual salary for a Tattooist in Tees Valley
