A big thank you to Jeff and his team at Newbury Christmas Tree farm for welcoming the Avenue School and donating our beautiful tree.











## Class 1B's Learning Through This Term's Topic: Food

This term, Class 1B have been exploring food through a variety of activities and learning opportunities. We have our daily breakfast sessions, in which we work on requesting different foods, as well as counting pieces of food and asking for 'lots' or 'a little' of what we want. We have also been exploring food through sensory play sessions, in which we are exposed to different scents,

textures and tastes, as well as OT tasks. On Mondays we have food technology session, where we make pitta pizzas. We use PECS and/or speech to request what we need and are getting really good at making our pizzas with very little support now. Every Tuesday we have participated in our sensory story, 'The Gingerbread Man'. As the term has gone on we have learned to listen to the story as a group, predict what will happen next in the story and to explore the props with less support.

On Thursdays we have been making fruit and vegetable print pictures during art session. We now use PECS and/or speech to request the resources that we need during these sessions. To end the term, we are exploring some Christmas foods when rehearsing for our Christmas performance.

## **Equine Therapy**


From the 27th September, every Wednesday afternoon, 4 students have been attending horse riding session at Riding for The Disabled in Hampstead Norreys

Each week, we have been improving on our listening, waiting and confidence skills.

All 4 students (Jessica, Insaf, Sebby and Hafsah) now ride at the same time, for a full half an hour! We have objects to put into a basket hoop, to improve our stability, balance and concentration. The adults enjoy this session as much as the students!

As from 6th December all 4 students have now experienced trotting. We had lots of giggles, and excited anticipation. The riding teacher has said that Insaf has one of the best sitting positions when trotting. Sebby really enjoyed looking at himself in the mirror and he waited beautifully before and after. 




## 'Christmas around the world'
