### About the Avenue

The Avenue Special Needs Academy is a day special school for children aged 2 - 19 with complex Special Educational Needs. All of our pupils have an Education and Health Care Plan.

All our pupils will have at least a Severe Learning Difficulty and some will have Profound and Multiple Learning Difficulties (PMLD), Autism, speech and language needs, physical needs, and a combination of the above.

**We are now offering to share our expertise with other schools and support SEN practice through our School2School support services.**

### Our Approach

The Avenue School believes in a positive ethos of PACE, based on mutual respect where we are all learning together, are committed to excellence, and focused on the development of the potential of all.
