In the kitchen we used liquids of different densities to make rainbow towers, as well as looking at the diffusion of colour which occurs when skittles are arranged in water - the magic happened before our very eyes!

In soft play there was an opportunity to observe forces, with toys to push and pull down the ramp.

Light and shadow play was available in the sensory room, and memory games were laid out in the library.

Students had an opportunity to test their fitness in the sports hall, completing a circuit and monitoring their pulse rates.


Arts Day on the Friday of Enrichment Week saw many activities on offer. There were Printmaking videos to watch for mono-printing and texture block printing.
