Old MacDonald

- pigs** (Verse 3): Sign showing one hand near the face with fingers curled.
- horses** (Verse 4): Sign showing hands in front of the chest with a downward arrow.
- children** (Verse 5): Sign showing one arm extended forward with three arrows pointing to the right.

Notes:

- 1 **MacDonald** - See a finger spelling chart
- 2 **Farm** - Use the second half of this two part sign
- 3 **Moo** - Repeat sign several times and move your head to indicate several cows
- 4 Make appropriate noises for pigs, horses and children in Verses 3, 4 and 5
